Title of Post: 1:1 Support Worker
Place of Work: Beannachar Camphill Community
Responsible to: House Co-ordinator/Workshop Leader
Purpose of Job:

We seek experienced support workers who are driven to support all to lead meaningful and rewarding lives. Currently, the need is principally to support from Mondays to Fridays, this may at times include some mornings and/ or evening (i.e. from 7 am, or to 9 p.m.), but usually the need will be from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. to support during our day programme working alongside a young adult in the workshops. At the moment the primary need will be to principally support one or both of the following young people:

A young man with a lively sense of humour, who likes a humorous and positive approach. He is diagnosed with autism and has epilepsy, experience with both is desirable, including administering rescue medication, but training will be provided if necessary.

A young and very active young woman. She likes to explore and look at everything happening around her. Diagnosed with autism. She benefits from a calm, consistent approach and likes to be kept active with suitable tasks and activities.

Both young people need some support with personal care, therefore we are seeking female candidates only for supporting the 2nd young person.

Salary

- Salary based on a 40 hour week: £19,760.00, pro rata for part time positions
- Holiday Entitlement 32 days per annum, pro rata for part time role – Employees are expected to take annual leave during the two week Christmas closure which is deducted from the annual leave entitlement.
